Shirts - in or out must fit!

**Clothes must** 

Neat and clean

fit properly

appearance

Must wear a belt if pants have loops

## DONTS

- Excessively tight or baggy clothing (SPANDEX)
- Obscene words or gestures on clothing
- Exposed undergarments
- Torn, ripped or frayed clothing
- See through or revealing clothing

No halter tops, exposed midriffs, short-shorts, or mini skirts

> No tank tops, doo rags, bandanas, backwards or sideways ball caps

Trousers worn at the waist

Sports jerseys should not be overly baggy ALL CIVILIAN HEADGEAR MUST BE REMOVED WHILE INSIDE MARINE CORPS BASE FACILITIES

DOS

- Marines will be clean shaved daily
- Ball caps worn like military cover
- Civilian attire should be worn as appropriate to the occasion

No shower shoes

No sports bra can be worn as an outer garments

> No physical fitness attire, spandex, or sweatpants inside non-gym
