Unrestricted Reporting vs Restricted Reporting

- An unrestricted report can be made via several channels, such as law enforcement, chain-of-command and Family Advocacy Program (FAP).
- Victims can receive an array of services to include medical treatment, command support, and referrals to additional resources.
- ALL REPORTS of child abuse are unrestricted.

- A restricted report can be made to a VA, FAP Clinical or DoD Healthcare Provider.
- No command or law enforcement involvement.
- Victims can receive victim advocacy services, such as referrals, information and safety planning, as well as clinical treatment.
